
Blue Ribbon Plant

Possible points: 100 Deductions: About 4 Final Score: 96



Gap either between rows or between leaves. Deduct 1-2 points.

Immature/smaller leaves should be removed. Deduct 1 point for each leaf.

Analysis:

This semi-miniature is immediately pleasing to the eye. There are plenty of flowers for this size plant, and they are fairly well distributed. Repositioning one or two bloom stalks could have made the bloom head more symmetrical and balanced.

The plant is clean and color is good for the variety. One or more of the smaller, hidden leaves on the lower row should be removed.

This plant would certainly be a blue ribbon, if not a best in class. With some minor modifications, it would be a good candidate for a collection class.

*From this photograph, we cannot know all the factors that determine the final score. Some of those factors include: the positioning of plant in the pot, the existence of suckers, neck or stalk nubs, whether or not the plant is in the appropriate size pot, or if the plant shows any signs of pests or has marred leaves.
